Car parking at South Oxford Community Centre

Our parking policy outlines our parking provisions in the courtyard area for users and visitors. We'll explain our criteria for allocating parking space and establish rules for using our parking premises.

Scope

This policy applies to all users who have been given written consent by the Management Committee of South Oxford Community Association and any visitors who need a parking space for health reasons.

Policy elements

Our parking policy revolves around:

- Our criteria and procedure for allocating parking spaces
- Preserving a safe and clean parking lot
- Rules for managing parking spaces

Criteria and Procedure for allocating parking spaces in the courtyard area

The assigned parking spaces are to be adhered to the letter, this allows adequate space for emergency evacuation of the Centre.

These spaces are;

- 1 spaces in front of the lower room to the right of the railing as entering the yard
- 1 space to the left of the railing as entering the yard
- 3 spaces alongside the garden to the left of the gate, parked towards the benches.

Preserving our parking lot

We expect drivers to maintain a clean and safe parking space. The following rules apply at all times:

- The gate to the park is to be kept locked at all times it is not in use and the park gate must be kept closed after a driver has driven through it.
- Drivers make take care when driving through the Hinksey Park.
- Drivers must respect others' property.
- Drivers shouldn't speed, turn carelessly or drive irresponsibly when entering the park or the yard.
- Drivers shouldn't conduct maintenance or repair jobs to their cars while they parked in the yard, except if they cannot start them.

Managing Parking spaces

Parking spaces aren't permanent benefits. We can withdraw them anytime as a result of disciplinary action or needs of people with higher priority. This benefit is valid only as long as the user is using the Centre for their class.

This policy does not restrict off-site parking. But, users are not allowed to:

- Block front or back entrances
- Park in the park grounds

Disciplinary Consequences

Any user who is found parking in unauthorized or prohibited areas or in other ways disregard this policy will receive a warning and a written reprimand. Repeat offence will result in retraction of parking benefit for the group.
